For our annual meeting this year we will be returning to Davenport Press Restaurant in Mineola for our luncheon on **Sunday, October 16th**. Originally a bank, the 1862 building later became a printing company and was the official county printer for many years. A restaurant since 1976, it is decorated with many antiques and historic photographs.

Our speaker will be Kerriann Flanagan Brosky whose talk will be "Historic Haunts of Long Island: Ghosts and Legends from the Gold Coast to Montauk Point." Her ghostly journey through Long Island history promises to be a captivating glimpse into her recent book on the topic (she'll have her *Historic Haunts* book available for sale and signing).

We will have a choice of five entrees (selections made at the table): oven roasted salmon; chicken francaise; sliced London broil with mushroom sauce; eggplant parmigiana; or rigatoni a la vodka. The meal includes tossed salad, vegetables, potatoes, dessert, soda or iced tea, and coffee or tea (cash bar). The luncheon is scheduled from 1 to 4 pm; our room will be available from 12:30. Turn right (north) on Main St. and the restaurant is on the right, north of Front St. and just before the LIRR tracks (south of 2nd St.). A parking lot is on the south side of the restaurant or park on the street (meters are free on Sunday).
